Book Appointment

Upload Patient Files

Go to our secure Client Portal or FileDrop Portal to upload your patient files (patient intake form, photos of the wound, health and medication summaries, etc. All files are secured during transfer with SSL/TLS encryption protocols and in storage using AES 256-bit encryption.

Connecting to Consult

You will be emailed a secure link to your video consult. Simply click the link at your scheduled appointment time and your consult will begin.

After the Consult

Following the consult, you will receive a report outlining recommendations for treatment. We usually schedule an appointment for one or two weeks after the first appointment to monitor progress.

Wounds are a significant problem... the solution starts with you!

When a person sustains an injury to their skin there is an expectation that the wound will heal within a matter of days or weeks. Yet for many, this is far from reality.

Wounds are often painful and debilitating, having a significant impact on the person and those who care for them.

There are a lot of factors that can lead to impaired wound healing such as the cause of the wound, how big it is, where it is located, the age of the person, the presence of other health conditions and lifestyle factors.

Wounds are estimated to affect approximately 450,000 Australian's and cost the health care system almost \$3 billion per annum. They are a significant and under-recognised public health issue.

Many wound sufferers find it very difficult to access health professionals with expertise in caring for wounds. They often experience high-costs associated with treatments, lengthy waiting lists to access care and inconsistencies in wound care practices.
